Proposals for the **working group sessions** should describe a need in Information Assurance Education or Training and develop a hypothesis to be discussed during the working group sessions. Each accepted submission will be briefed in a plenary session prior to breaking into working groups. The working group discussions will span three sessions. Results from each working group session will be briefed in a final plenary session

Paper session submissions will be presented by authors in plenary paper sessions. Relevant topics include, but are not limited to the following:

Authors are requested to submit original work, not previously published; limited to 8 pages. Papers must be written and presented in English. All submissions will be reviewed double blind and should be submitted in a form suitable for anonymous review. Each paper should be submitted in a full and blinded version (author information removed). Submissions instructions are available on the conference website. Selection for presentation at the conference and publication in the proceedings will be based upon originality, contribution to the field, and relevance to the conference. The conference proceedings will be published and distributed at the conference. Accepted papers will only be published in the proceedings if one of the authors presents the paper at the conference.
