All submissions will be reviewed double blind and should be submitted in a form suitable for anonymous review. Selection for publication in the proceedings will be based upon originality, contribution to the field, and relevance to the conference. The conference proceedings will be published and distributed at the conference. Accepted papers will only be published in the proceedings if one of the authors presents the paper at the conference.
